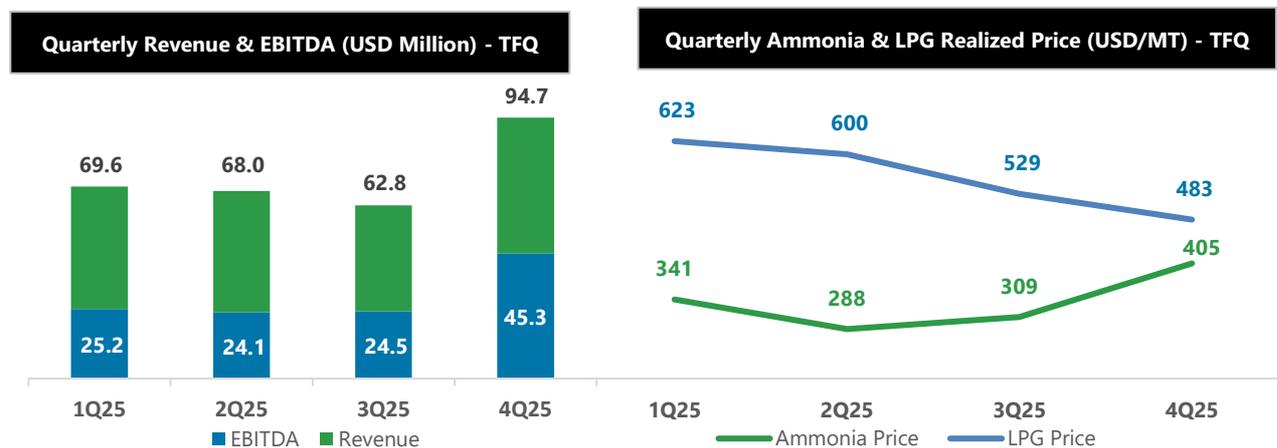
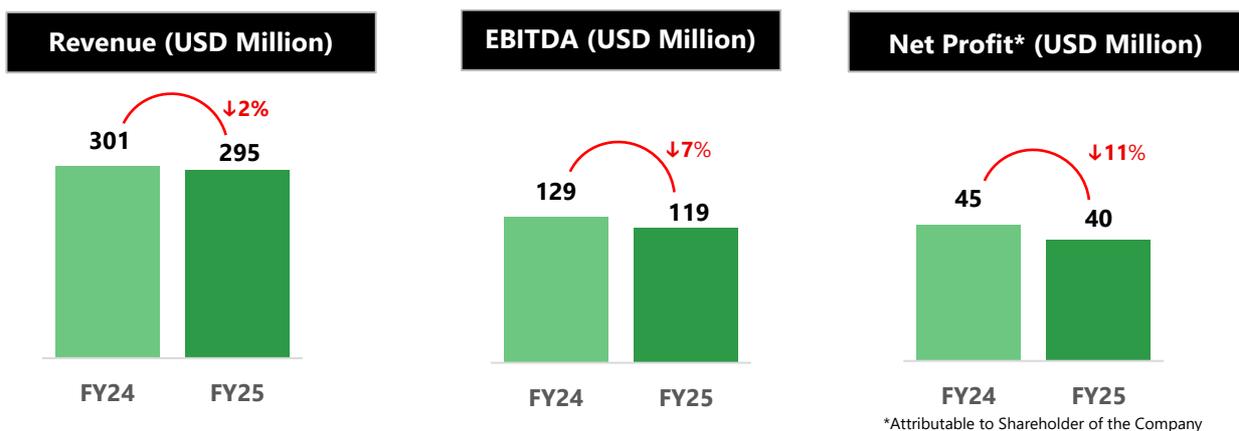


## ESSA's Strong Q4 Performance Lifts 2025 Results Close to Prior Year Levels

**Jakarta, 6 March 2026** — PT ESSA Industries Indonesia Tbk ("ESSA"), a publicly listed company engaged in the Energy and Chemicals sector through its LPG (Liquefied Petroleum Gas) refinery and Ammonia plant, has further strengthened its financial position since making early repayment of all its loans in 2025. The stellar 4Q25 performance was driven by a sharp rebound in ammonia prices, which jumped 31% QoQ. ESSA's robust operations backed by plant reliability were instrumental in capturing the price upside amidst global ammonia supply issues. As a result, 4Q25 revenue increased by 51% QoQ, while net profit rose by 194% QoQ, highlighting the Company's strong operational leverage and agility in responding to market changes.



On a full-year basis, the Company posted a revenue of USD 295 million, a marginal decline of 2% YoY despite LPG & ammonia prices being lower by 8% and 3.5% respectively YoY. While the topline remained resilient supported by 3% higher ammonia dispatches, the bottom-line was primarily impacted by the lower sales realizations. Reduction in financial charges due to prepayment of loans, partly offset the impact of lower sales realization in Net Profit.



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**Kanishk Laroya – President Director & CEO of ESSA** said “Optimum operating levels along with high plant reliability were the key to ESSA’s robust operations which off-set, to a large extent, the impact of lower prices in the topline. Our LPG plant has clocked more than 6.5 years of “Zero plant trip” while ammonia plant has completed 9.4 million safe manhours – a testament to ESSA’s operational excellence. This year we will be undertaking scheduled turnaround for our ammonia plant in 2Q26, helping us ensure long-term safety, reliability, efficiency, and sustainability. Prudent financial management also helped us in reducing our interest expenses and supporting our bottom-line. In 2025, we became debt-free with a net cash of USD 126 million putting ESSA in a good position to leverage its Balance Sheet for growth opportunities”.
